This entry tells us that there are 5 German Shepherd Dogs and they are broken down as follows  
  
2 "Open" dogs – 1 "Open" bitches -2 "Special" dogs – 0 "Special" bitches  
  
"Open" means the dog/bitch has not earned its Championship  
  
"Special" means the dog/bitch has earned its Championship.
