CODE OF ETHICS JUNE 1992

1. This code of ethics shall establish a standard of conduct to be followed by all members of The Pensacola Dog Fancier's Association, Inc., in the normal course of breeding, selling, exhibiting, and judging dogs.

2. No member shall knowingly sell puppies or breeding stock to pet dealers, catalog houses, pet brokers, or other commercial sources; nor shall dogs be given as prizes in contests or exploited to the detriment of dogs; nor shall any member violate interstate commerce laws in the shipping of animals.

3. Any dog sold with breeding papers shall be without defect to the degree that these defects shall interfere with its normal function as a suitable pet or companion.

4. All dogs shall be sold in good condition, free from communicable disease, with health guaranteed for a reasonable length of time.

5. All dogs offered at stud shall be in good health and free from communicable disease. Dogs known to be sterile or cryptorchids shall not be offered at stud. Bitches to be bred shall also be in good health and free from communicable disease. Stud owner shall inform customer of any disqualifying defects.

6. Bitches presented for stud service shall be bred to selected stud only. Owner of bitch is to be consulted before any other stud is used.

7. Only an actual witnessed tie or artificial insemination in accordance with AKC rules shall be considered a breeding unless otherwise mutually agreed to by both parties.

8. All financial arrangements shall be made in advance of sales or service and agreed to in writing by both parties.

9. All advertising shall be honest and not in any way misrepresentative or fraudulent. Variety of breed shall be so designated in all advertising.

10. Whether at home, traveling, at shows or motels, all members shall conduct themselves at all times in such manner as to reflect credit on the dog show event and dogs in particular.

11. No member shall knowingly breed dogs for dog fighting or condone dog fighting in any form; nor train dogs to be vicious or attack dogs; nor mistreat or be cruel to any dog or animal.

12. No member shall knowingly sell dogs or place dogs with medical labs, drug companies or any other facility for the purpose of testing in any form; nor breed dogs for the purpose of sale to or placement with medical labs, drug companies or any other facility for purpose of testing in any form.

13. No member shall knowingly alter any dog in any manner other than approved cropping in accordance with breed standards; nor falsify records pertaining to dog breeding, registration, show entries, health or any other record on the history of any dog.

14. Members shall breed pure bred dogs with the intent to improve the breed; furthermore, members shall to the best of their ability take reasonably good care and provide proper food and shelter for all dogs in their custody.

15. Members shall keep complete records in accordance with AKC rules and which is pertinent to the history of any dog or litter; furthermore, members shall abide by all state, federal, and local laws regarding and pertaining to dogs.

16. Members shall take reasonable care in placing puppies or unwanted dogs in good homes with instructions to the new owner(s) of the dog or puppy's needs and owner responsibilities; furthermore, members shall honestly inform potential new owners of the dog or puppy's quality, pet or show, to best of their knowledge and/or ability.

17. Members shall provide reasonable and good veterinarian care and attention to all dogs as may be required to maintain their dog's health to the best of the member's ability.

18. All potential members shall be shown a copy of this code of ethics when applying for membership in the Pensacola Dog Fancier's Association, Inc., and by the act of signing the application, shall signify their acceptance of this code in its entirety. Any member violating this code either in content or intent shall be answerable to the Pensacola Dog Fancier's Association, Inc. Board.
